



LAKESIDE CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP Leadership Council Report for May 8, 2023

The Leadership Council meeting was called to order at 2:05PM by moderator Fred Pontesso. Council members present were Fred Pontesso, Judy Guthrie, Warwick Andrews, Bill Bush and Jack Tyler. Also present were Pastor Chuck Smith and Music Minister Bill Parcher. A quorum was present.

Invocation: Bill Parcher opened with a prayer.

Opening Remarks: "Thoughts to Ponder" – Fred Pontesso stated "When you think about quitting, think about why you started!"

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the April 10th council meeting were approved by acclimation.

Commission Reports:

<u>Financial Update</u> – Warwick Andrews reported that although our income is still slightly below budget, our church treasury is financially healthy.

Stewardship Commission – No report.

Warwick stated that this commission will become active in July when commission budgets are prepared for the coming year and the committee will begin planning for the stewardship campaign.

Building and Grounds – Bill Bush reported that the chair manufacturer is now unable to provide the fabric for the arm chairs we ordered. Bill made a motion that we cancel the existing chair order and just order arms and hardware as needed to modify some of the existing chairs we have. (1) Jack Tyler seconded the motion. A vote was held and motion carried. It is hoped that the

modified chairs will be available by mid-June. Bill stated that the measurements have been completed for the installation of the new front doors for the Sanctuary but an installation date has not yet been set. The building owners have agreed to share in the cost of the doors and installation. It was discovered at the Sunday service that our piano needs some sound adjustment and a servicing. Bill Bush and Warwick Andrews will contact the Hill Country Singers Board treasurer to discuss this repair need and cost.

<u>Faith in Action</u> – Jan Robbins was not present so there was no report.

Worship Commission – Genie Carroll was not present so there was no report. Pastor Chuck Smith provided average attendance information for the month of April as follows: in person attendance-42; watching remotely -35; website visitors-42; average total viewership – 77.

Pastoral Relations – Jack Tyler reported that due to recent decisions made by the council he and his committee will be reviewing the terms of the employment contract for our full-time pastor as well as job requirements. These documents will be revised and amended as needed. The revised contract will be presented to the congregation for approval at the annual meeting in October. All employee reviews need to be done so preparation for these will be discussed with his committee.

<u>Ministries</u> – June Freeman was not present to give her report.

Old Business - Further discussion was held regarding the need for greater exposure

New Business – There were no new suggestions found in the suggestion box. Chuck Smith presented a ministers' preaching schedule for the next three months to the council. The sign is owned by Enrique Lopez who owns the properties adjacent to our church. Chuck Smith will contact Enrique to

discuss updating the appearance of this sign.


<u>Future Topics</u> - The next meeting will be held on June 12, 2023.









