The leadership council meeting was called to by no later than 7/20/2023. The commission order at 2:04PM by Moderator Fred Pontesso. Council members present were Fred Pontesso, Judy Guthrie, Warwick Andrews, June Freeman, and Jack Tyler. Also present were Pastor Chuck Smith and Music Minister Bill Parcher. Bill Bush attended briefly by phone but presented his report by email. A quorum was present.

Pastor Chuck Smith opened Invocation: with a prayer.

Opening Remarks: "Thoughts to Ponder" – Fred Pontesso stated "Do something today that your future self will thank you for".

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the May 8th council meeting were approved by acclimation.

Commission Reports:

Financial Update – Warwick Andrews reported that our net income is down year to date by \$19,000 but our church treasury is still financially healthy. Warwick made a motion (1) that he investigates putting an additional \$50,000 from our money market into another 12 month CD since rates are averaging close to or slightly about 5% interest. The money market earns a minute amount of interest that is less than .002%. Jack Tyler seconded the motion. A vote was held and motion carried. Warwick will report back to the council the exact amount of interest the CD will earn before transferring any funds to it.

Stewardship Commission - Budget preparation sheets for the 2024 calendar year were passed out to each commission chairman. Completed budgets are to be returned to the church of

will then meet in August to compile the church budget for 2024 and present it to the council at the August meeting.

Building and Grounds - Bill Bush reported that arms have been fitted to 11 chairs which are now in place in the Sanctuary. The lock on the fireproof file cabinet in the office has been replaced. The faded LCF advertising sign that was in Jonestown has been removed. signs are leaning against the wall next to the men's restroom in case they can be remade for future use. The new external doors to the sanctuary are on order. Delivery is expected around mid-July. The building owner said they will look into equipping the doors with "magnetic locks" that will provide additional security. Bill has received two quotes for installation of the doors. Another small item to be determined is a delivery charge for the doors. A new wi-fi router was installed after the power fault so devices accessible over the internet had to be reconfigured for the new router. Pastor Chuck and Rodger Elliott reconnected the Govee temperature sensors and Bill reconnected the Flume Water Meter so that all devices are back on-line and visible over the internet. Also, our piano has been re-tuned. Bill Bush has truly been busy even though he has been going back and forth from Lago Vista to New York. Thank you, Bill!

Bill provided and update on the work of the **Long Range Planning Team** which consists of Bill Bush, Edwina Woolsey, Lance Bass, Chip Hamilton and Advisor Chuck Smith. The team met on 6/5/2023 to continue their work on constructing a survey/questionnaire to be distributed to the congregation. Feedback an-

building a Plan of Action for LCF over the next 3 to 5 years. All information and feedback from the surveys will be reviewed and approved by the Leadership Council prior to its use. The survey/questionnaires will be lengthy so they will be presented to the congregation in 4-6 partial releases. The surveys will contain a Letter from the Pastor; an introduction; vision and mission statements; table of goals, objectives, and actions; and an appendix with a summary of survey results and possibly a summary of community demographics.

Faith In Action - Jan Robbins was not present and no report was provided.

Worship Commission - Genie Carroll was not present so no report was given

Pastoral Relations – Jack Tyler provided an updated Job Summary for the church Pastor and his Employment Contract for the council's review. After review by each member, Jack made a motion (2) that the Council approve these documents. Motion was seconded by Warwick Andrews. A vote was held and motion

Ministries - June Freeman reported that July 30th is a 5th Sunday and a potluck luncheon will be held after Bill Parcher's gospel service. Bill Parcher will create a form to be included in the next several weekly bulletins for the congregation to request their favorite hymns to be sung during the time that the choir will on vacation through August.

New Business - The council discussed two suggestions from the suggestion box. One had was a suggestion to hold a church garage sale.

swers from the survey will assist the team in The council's concern with a garage sale was how to dispose of unsold items. As an alternative, June Freeman mentioned considering a church bake sale. Debbie Reed will be on vacation from August 5-12th and September 11-17th. During these times Linda Anderson will be handling office duties. Warwick Andrews suggested that any people inquiring at the church office for financial assistance be referred to the Hope Center for help since most churches in our community support this center. A discussion was held and all council members agreed. Warwick Andrews made a motion (3) that two signs are posted in the windows of the Sanctuary doors and the office doors stating that "no cash is held on these premises" and "anyone in need of financial aid should go to the Hope Center located on Dawn Drive". Motion was seconded by Judy Guthrie. A vote was held and motion carried. Pastor Chuck Smith stated that our church has been given permission from Enrique Lopez, owner of the lots at the corner of American Drive and Highland Lake Drive, to place a large sign containing information on the church and service times on the corner which can be seen from all directions. Some clean up work on the site must be done before a sign can be installed.




